Peake Class have been working very hard on their Math and English. They enjoyed a visit to church and all followed the 5 S's walking to and from the Easter service. Well done to Peake!

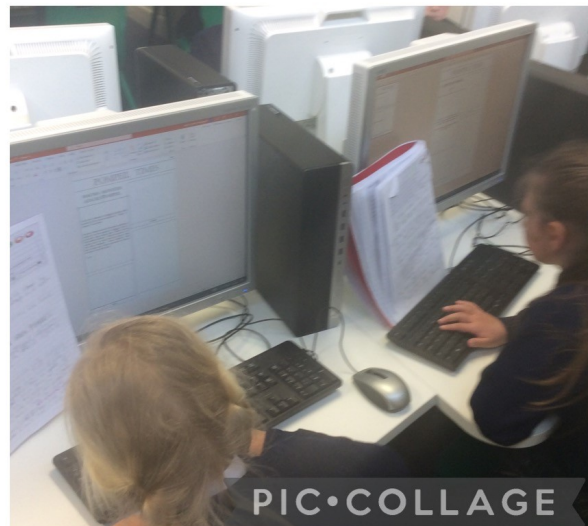
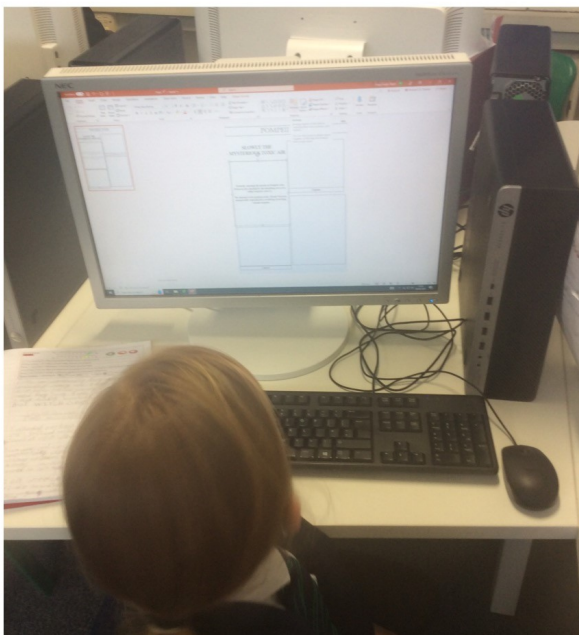
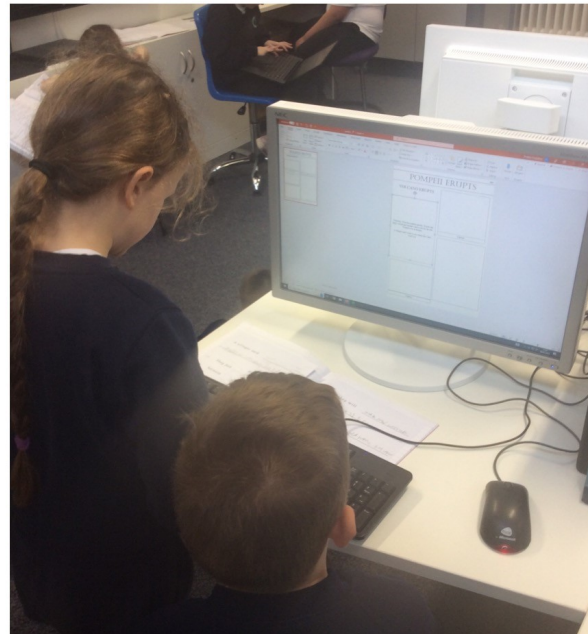
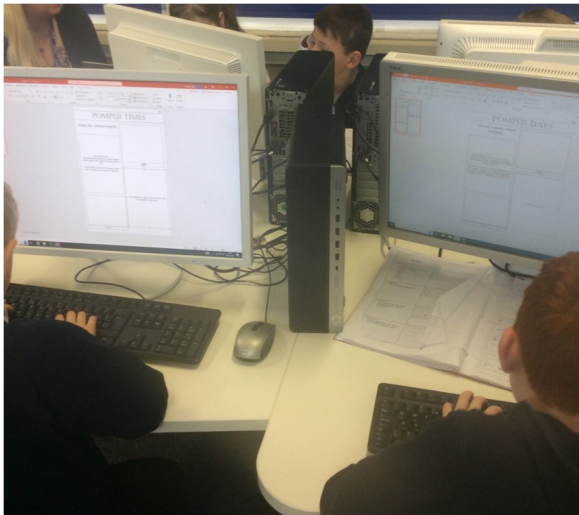

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Year 4 have enjoyed sculpting with clay again this week.

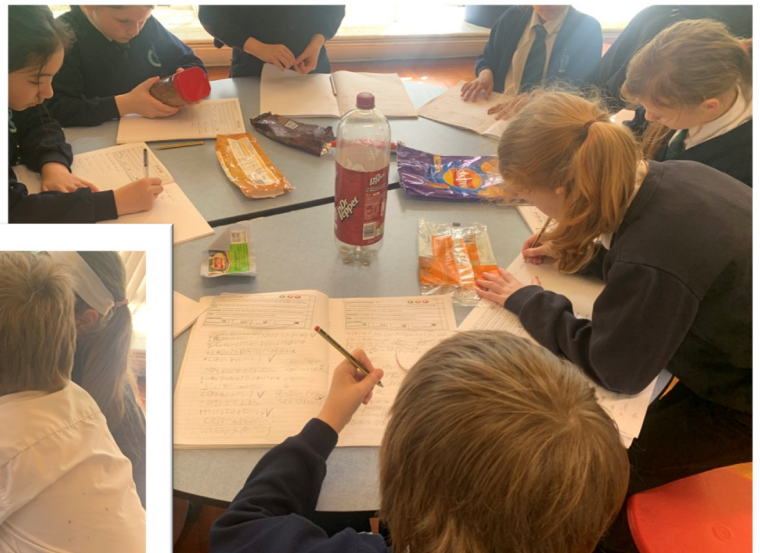


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Head Teacher to Home—31 March What has happened in school this week?

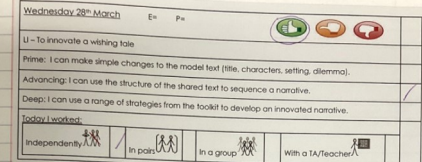
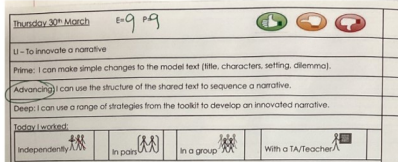
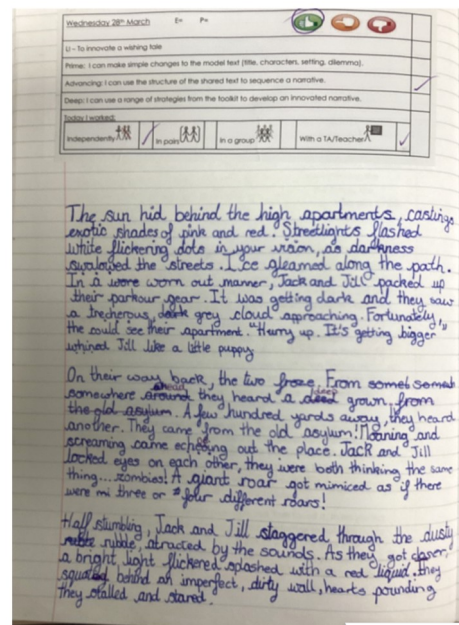


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Head Teacher to Home—31 March What has happened in school this week?

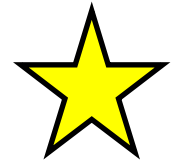

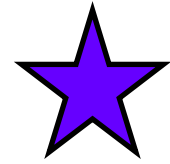

Congratulations to Drew Class who had the highest attendance in Key Stage 2 this week!



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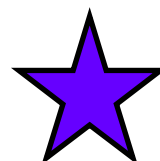
